

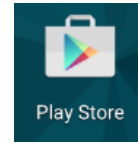


- Parents can proceed to access the mobile apps after they have created their PowerSchool accounts via the web portal.
- Students can proceed to access the mobile apps after they receive login information (username/password).

## PUBLIC PORTAL MOBILE APPS

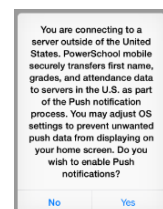
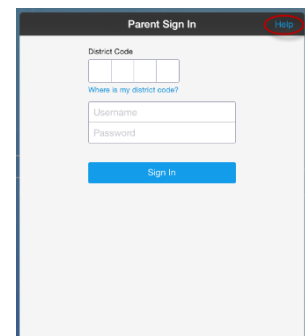
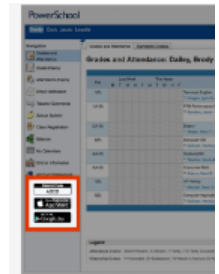
To download the PowerSchool App:

1. Navigate to the App Store or Play Store.
2. In the Search bar, type: PowerSchool.
3. Touch **Search**.
4. A list will open, Select **PowerSchool Mobile**.
5. On the iPad or iPhone, touch **Get**.
  - a. Touch **Install**.
  - b. Enter your Apple ID password in the Sign in to iTunes Store pop-up.
  - c. Touch **Ok**.
  - d. The app will download.
  - e. Touch **Open**.



To log in to the PowerSchool App use the District Code from the bottom, left corner of the PowerSchool Web Portal Start Page.

1. To access the District Code:
  - a. Log in to the Public Portal on a computer.
  - b. View the District Code in the lower, left corner of the Start Page.
2. To Log into the PowerSchool App using the District Code:
  - a. Open the PowerSchool Parent/Student App.
  - b. Enter the **District Code**.
  - c. Enter your PowerSchool **Username**.
  - d. Enter your PowerSchool **Password**.
  - e. Touch **Sign In**.
  - f. Determine if you would like Push Notifications enabled.
    - i. Push Notifications give alerts and related information for apps.
    - ii. Push Notifications require a Wi-Fi or cellular connection.
    - iii. Push Notifications can be reviewed and edited within Settings.





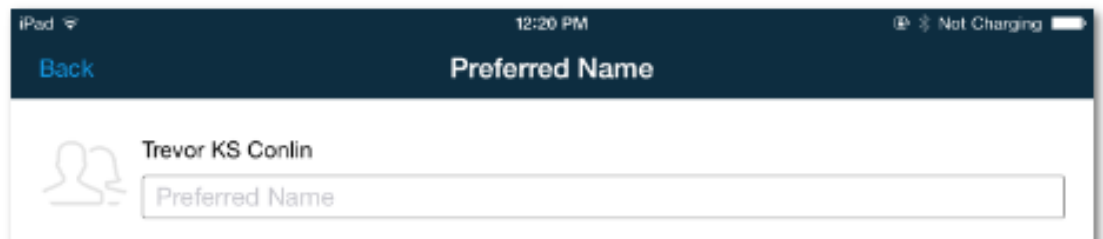
Included in the mobile app are the following features:

1. **Dashboard** is open on login.
  - a. The Live Feed screen is displayed with grades, attendance and course information.
  - b. Dots below Dashboard represent students attached to parent account. (Parent Login)
  - c. Left and Right Arrows – Switch between students. (Parent Login)

2. **Filter** – Filter Dashboard settings.
3. Touch the photo icon to view the student photo.
  - a. Touch **Edit**.
    - i. **Choose Photo** – Choose an existing photo from the device
    - ii. **Update from Server** – Updates the photo from the PowerSchool server.
    - iii. **Take Photo** – Take a photo using the device camera.

4. Student Name – Touch the student name to set a preferred name for the student.



5. Swipe a finger from left to right to open the Menu.
6. Swipe a finger from right to left to close the Menu. Once closed, a back arrow appears to reopen the menu.





PowerSchool options with the mobile app include:

1. Touch the arrow next to the menu item to view the following menu, use the Filter within each menu item to alter settings:
  - a. [Dashboard](#) – View the Dashboard.
  - b. [Grades](#) – View student’s grades.
  - c. [Assignments](#) – View student’s assignments and scores.
  - d. [Attendance](#) – View attendance.
  - e. [Schedule](#) – View student’s current schedule.
  - f. [Fees/Meals](#) – View fee and meal transactions if available.
  - g. [Teachers](#) – View the student’s teachers and their related course.
  - h. [Activities](#) – View student activities.
  - i. [Email Alerts](#) (Parent login) – Set up email notifications and frequency.
  - j. [Live Feed](#) – Live Feed of various items related to each student.
  - k. [Summaries](#) (Parent Login) – Current absences, GPA and fees for each student.
  - l. [Announcements](#) – View school announcements.
  - m. [Calendar](#) – View the calendar. A dot on the date indicates an associated item.
  - n. [School Map](#) – School maps if available. (Not available on Android.)
  - o. [Settings](#) - Settings associated with the app.
  - p. [Help Center](#) – Help menu relating to the app.
  - q. [Logout](#) – Log out of the PowerSchool App.
